
This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of respondent's motion to dismiss complaint and amended complaint, it is ordered by the court that the motion to dismiss is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.

It is further ordered that relator's emergency motion to compel is denied.

It is further ordered that relator's motion to take judicial notice of this court case number 2022 OHIO-3990 paragraph 18, motion to compel, and motion to strike are denied as moot.

It is further ordered that respondent's motion to declare relator a vexatious litigator is granted and Amirah Sultaana is found to be a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B). Accordingly, it is ordered by the court that Amirah Sultaana is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this court without first obtaining leave. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the clerk of this court for the court's review.
