On this 6th day of May, 1997, this cause came on for consideration for Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment to declare Defendant a vexatious litigator, that Defendant be subjected to the restrictions and disabilities attendant thereto including the disabilities under sections 2323.52, 2743.09, 2743.10, 2303.08, 1907.20, and 1901.31 of the Ohio Revised Code, and that Defendant be ordered responsible for court costs; and the Court finding such motion well taken;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant be adjudged a vexatious litigator as defined in section 2323.52 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Defendant shall be prohibited indefinitely from doing one or


more of the following without first obtaining the leave of this Court to proceed: Instituting legal proceedings in a Court of Claims, or a Court of Common Pleas, Municipal Court, or County Court; Continuing any legal proceedings that the vexatious litigator has instituted in a Court of Claims, or a Court of Common Pleas, Municipal Court, or County Court, prior to the entry of this order; Making any application, other than an application for leave to proceed under Division (F) of section 2323.52 of the Ohio Revised Code, in any legal proceedings instituted in the Court of Common Pleas.

It is further ordered, that case no. 97-CVH-071, Jean Kosanovich v. Ottawa County Dispatcher, Ottawa County Sheriff's Dept., et al., and case no. 97-CVC-077, Jean Kosanovich, et al. v. Ottawa County Sheriff's Dept., et al. are hereby dismissed with prejudice.

Defendant, Jean Kosanovich, shall pay the costs hereof.
