Instructions for Completing Form A Supplement for Commercial Dockets

Each judge assigned to hear commercial docket cases shall submit to the Case Management Section of the Supreme Court of Ohio each month a copy of this Form A Supplement for Commercial Dockets pursuant to the general reporting requirements prescribed under Sup. R. 37 and in accordance with the Instructions for Preparation of All Report Forms.

All cases assigned to a commercial docket judge shall retain their originating case type classification and shall continue to be reported by the Commercial Docket Judge in their traditional Form A report. Accordingly, the case counts reported in this Form A Supplement for Commercial Dockets will be a subset of the case counts reported in the judge's traditional Form A report.

Where this Form A Supplement for Commercial Dockets varies from the standard Form A, the following instructions apply:

1. All cases assigned to a commercial docket judge during the reporting month shall be reported in Line 2 except for cases first assigned to another commercial docket judge and then transferred to the reporting judge during the reporting month in which instance they shall be reported in Line 3. Cases previously terminated by the reporting judge that subsequently become reactivated shall be reported in Line 4.
2. Cases terminated by a court trial heard by a Special Master shall be reported in Line 8.
3. Cases terminated through mediation shall be reported in Line 9.
