

Notice: NCBE fees to increase effective July 1, 2015.

The National Conference of Bar Examiners has announced a fee increase as of July 1, 2015. The increased fees apply to the character report required as part of the Application to Register as a Candidate for Admission to the Practice of Law in Ohio (Registration Application).

The new fee schedule is as follows:

Timely Law Student Registrant - \$225

Registration Application is filed by November 15 of your second year of law school.

Late Law Student Registrant / First Admission of Recent Graduate - \$315

Registration Application is filed after November 15 of your second year of law school but within one year after graduating from law school, provided you are not admitted to the practice of law in another jurisdiction.

Late Graduate / Admitted to Practice - \$450

Registration Application is filed more than one year after graduating from law school OR you are admitted to the practice of law in another jurisdiction.

Foreign Education / Foreign Licensed Attorney - \$825

Current or former member of a bar of a foreign country seeking admission OR if your first law degree was not obtained in the United States.
