


King County Detention and Alternatives Report (2016)



Average Daily Population: Mean number of inmates in the custodial populations on a daily basis.

Year To Date Average: Average daily populations for each month, averaged for the year.

Avg. Jail Population: Average population of inmates who are confined in the King County Correctional Facility (KCCF) or Regional Justice Center (RJC), and partially confined in Work education Release or Electronic Home Detention.

Felony Sentenced: The year to date average daily population of inmates who from the time the sentence date is entered to completion of the sentence. Serving a sentence. Not eligible for pretrial release.

Pre-Sentence Felony: The year to date average daily population of inmates who are in the process from the time of arrest to the time of sentencing for felony matters. The most serious offense is the only offense looked at to determine pre-sentenced. Does include people who are "pure" pretrial and those with other sentenced matters. Might be eligible for pretrial release.

Sentenced Misdemeanant: The year to date average daily population of inmates who from the time the sentence date is entered to completion of the sentence. Serving a sentence. Not eligible for pretrial release. Not eligible for pretrial release.

Pre-Sentenced Misdemeanant: The year to date average daily population of inmates who are in the process from the time of arrest to the time of sentencing for Misdemeanor matters. The most serious offense is the only offense looked at to determine pre-sentenced. Does include people who are "pure" pretrial and those with other sentenced matters. Might be eligible for pretrial release.

Holds (includes state & other): The year to date average daily population of inmates who have been sentenced to DOC awaiting transfer to the state institution, and there are those inmates who are accused of violating a condition of their felony sentence including probation, Community Supervision, Post-release Supervision, Insanity Acquittal, Community Custody, Interstate Detainer, Parole, and State Work Release. It also includes those prisoners who are already serving a prison sentence, but are returned to face new charges or for other court related matters as well as held for such reasons as immigration, federal charge, transient, other county holds and fugitive. Not eligible for pretrial release.

Secure Confinement Population: Total confinement within a 24-hour detention facility in either KCCF or RJC. Likely not eligible for pretrial release.

Electronic Home Detention: The year to date average daily population of inmates in a program that allows offenders to be maintained under electronic surveillance within their home and work site. This program requires random drug and alcohol testing. People on EHD are considered to be in-custody. Likely not eligible for pretrial release.

Work Education Release: The year to date average daily population of inmates in a custodial community corrections program operated by DAJD that allows inmates to be released from custody in order to go to work and/or school. When they are not at work and/or school, the inmates are in-custody. Likely not eligible for pretrial release.
