

Guardian ad Litem Education Program Pre-Service Education

This course is designed for attorneys and non-attorneys who are involved, or wish to become involved, with guardian ad litem (GAL) service in their local courts. This course will satisfy the Supreme Court of Ohio Rule of Superintendence (Sup. R. 48) requiring that guardians ad litem serving in domestic relations and juvenile courts complete at least six hours of pre-service educational programming.

GAL Continuing Education Requirements

Under the Supreme Court of Ohio Guardian ad Litem Rule (Sup.R. 48), each GAL will also be required to attend a three hour continuing education course annually every calendar year after attending the pre-service course in order to remain in compliance with the rule. The Judicial College's interpretation of this section of the rule will require that GALs begin to take these three hour courses in 2010. There will be no three hour courses offered in 2009. 
Directions


