Course Description.

This training is required under Rule 16 of the Rules of Superintendence for the courts of Ohio, for all mediators who wish to receive child protection mediation referrals from an Ohio court. Participants will discuss the legal and social theories behind mediating this case type, explain the various stakeholders that need to be involved both in program planning and in the mediation process, and practice conducting these multi-party mediations. Topics will include terminology related to Ohio dependency law, the court process, mediating within statutory parameters, domestic abuse, child abuse, impact of socio-economic and diversity factors, and strengthening community resources and referral systems.

Who Should Attend

This advanced Rule 16 required training, is designed for Ohio mediators who meet the following prerequisites:

1) Basic Mediation Training (minimum 12 hours); 2) Specialized Family/Divorce Mediation Training (minimum 40 hours); 3) Domestic Abuse Issues (minimum 14 hours); 4) A minimum of 30 mediation sessions; 5) At least two years of professional experience with families; 6) Possess a bachelor's degree, or equivalent education experience as is satisfactory to the court that will be referring cases to the mediator; 7) A recommendation by a current Ohio judge with jurisdiction over abuse, neglect, and dependency cases.

To finalize your registration, you must complete and submit the Prerequisites Form (which begins on page two of this brochure) by November 12, 2013.
