**Description.** This training is designed for mediators and attorneys who represent clients in mediation. Faculty will provide an overview of substance abuse, chemical dependency and mental health concerns in the legal profession. This training will also explore ethics and professionalism and examine mediation best practices, mediator neutrality/impartiality, party self-determination, confidentiality, and privilege pursuant to the Uniform Mediation Act. Additional topics include a discussion of mediation related sections of the Rules of Professional Conduct, Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio, and the Rules of Superintendence for the Courts of Ohio. Faculty will also provide an overview of the Model Standards of Conduct for Mediators and Model Standards of Practice for Family and Divorce Mediation. Participants will examine and discuss the statutory, ethical, and professional obligations of attorney mediators as well as attorneys who represent clients in mediation
