Course Description. Participants will be introduced to concepts that underpin the practice of mediation: conflict theory, communication skills, interest based negotiation and mediator styles and qualifications. Participants will learn the basic stages of mediation, co-mediation and effective ways to address common mediation challenges: emotional dynamics, difficult personalities, impasse, ethical dilemmas and impartiality. This training is highly interactive and fosters participation through group discussion and involvement in small group mediation simulations and exercises. Mediation simulations and exercises are drawn from a variety of court mediation practices, giving participants familiarity with the different settings in which courts use mediation. This training will also familiarize participants with the provisions and scope of the Uniform Mediation Act (ORC 2710). Participants will discuss specific privileges and exceptions to those privileges with a comparison to confidentiality in addition to the role of party and non-party participants and the rights of clients.
