**ORDER**

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 health crisis, the following Court Order is made for those employees at the Guernsey County Courthouse and any visitors to the Guernsey County Courthouse, excepting the inmates from the Guernsey County Jail:

Effective immediately, all county employees who work primarily at the Guernsey County Courthouse shall each morning take their temperature before coming to work, or if no thermometer at home is available to the employee, take their own temperature prior to passing through the security clearance at the Courthouse. Any employee who is experiencing a fever shall not report to work. If an employee becomes ill during the day, that employee shall report their illness to their supervisor and shall immediately leave the Courthouse and go home.

All visitors to the Courthouse will be greeted by the Court's Security Officer, or their designee. The information gathered from the visitors shall be the visitor's name, whether the visitor is feeling well, whether they have a fever, and the visitor shall take their own temperature with the information obtained being logged by the Court Security Officer or their designee. That log shall be kept and maintained in the ordinary course of business.


Anyone who, within the last fourteen (14) days, has been exposed to someone confirmed to have COVID-19, is prohibited from entering the Courthouse.

Each department shall continue with the employee wellness log.
