The Massillon Municipal Court continues to remain flexible in response to ongoing public health emergencies. Accordingly, Court policies must and will continue to adapt and change. The Court will continue to implement safety and health measures to protect the public, attorneys and our staff. In consideration, the Court issues the following order concerning access to the Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED:

That, effective Wednesday, June 3, 2020, all requests by law enforcement for a finding of probable cause must be submitted to the Court by 3:00 pm each day. After that time, it will be necessary to contact the Judge conducting arraignments.

That, effective Wednesday, June 3, 2020, public access to the Court building will close at 4:30 pm each day. All Court business, including court filings, must be conducted by 4:00 pm or other arrangements made with each individual Judge or Magistrate concerning the conducting of remote proceedings or court filings.
