**2017-0553. Delphi Automotive Sys., L.L.C. v. Ohio Dept. of Job & Family Servs., Slip Opinion No. 2020-Ohio-2793.**

Franklin App. No. 14AP-971, 2017-Ohio-809. Judgment reversed and trial court's judgment reinstated.
