JUDGMENT ENTRY

{¶1} On February 14, 2020, the magistrate issued a decision recommending judgment for plaintiff in the amount of \$172,831.49, which includes an award of damages, prejudgment interest, and the filing fee paid by plaintiff. The magistrate also issued a decision recommending that plaintiff's motion for attorney fees be denied and plaintiff's motion to strike be granted.

{¶2} Civ.R. 53(D)(3)(b)(i) states, in part: "A party may file written objections to a magistrate's decision within fourteen days of the filing of the decision, whether or not the court has adopted the decision during that fourteen-day period as permitted by Civ.R. 53(D)(4)(e)(i)." No objections were filed.

{¶3} The court determines that there is no error of law or other defect evident on the face of the magistrate's decisions. Therefore, the court adopts the magistrate's decisions and recommendations as its own, including findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein.

{¶4} Judgment is rendered for plaintiff in the amount of \$173,233.52 which includes an additional 20 days of prejudgment interest. Plaintiff's motion for attorney fees is DENIED and plaintiff's motion to strike is GRANTED. Court costs are assessed against

defendant. The clerk shall serve upon all parties notice of this judgment and its date of entry upon the journal.
