ENTRY ADOPTING
REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

{¶1} Before the court is a special master's report and recommendation (R&R) of December 19, 2019. The special master has recommended denying requester's claim for production of records. Neither requester nor respondent has timely filed written objections to the special master's R&R.

{¶2} Pursuant to R.C. 2743.75(F)(2), if neither party timely objects to a special master's report and recommendation, this court is required to "promptly issue a final order adopting the report and recommendation, unless it determines that there is an error of law or other defect evident on the face of the report and recommendation."
