92-1558. Sawchyn v. Buckeye Union Ins. Co.
Cuyahoga County, No. 60510. This cause, pending before the court on the
filing of a motion for an order directing the Court of Appeals for
Cuyahoga County to certify its record and as a claimed appeal as of right
from said court, was considered in a manner prescribed by law. On
