MERIT DOCKET

92-1816. State v. Campbell.
Fulton County, No. 91FU000017. This cause, here on appeal from the
Court of Appeals for Fulton County, was considered in the manner
prescribed by law. On consideration thereof, this cause is dismissed,
sua sponte, effective October 14, 1993, for want of the defendant's
right in such cases to appeal.

It is further ordered that the appellee recover from the
appellant its costs herein expended; and that a mandate be sent to the
Court of Common Pleas of Fulton County to carry this judgment into
execution; and that a copy of this entry be certified to the Clerk of
the Court of Appeals for Fulton County for entry.

93-1933. Portis v. Summit Cty. Bd. of Elections.
This cause is pending before the court as an appeal under R.C. 3515.15
from the Court of Common Pleas of Summit County. Upon consideration
of appellee's motions to dismiss and to strike evidence,

IT IS ORDERED by this court that the motions to dismiss and to
strike be, and hereby are, denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this court that the judgment of the
Court of Common Pleas is reversed and the Court of Common Pleas is
directed to order the return of Ernest J. Tarle to the ballot as the
Democratic nominee for the Fifth Ward Council seat for the November

General Election, consistent with the opinion to follow.

92-2254. State ex rel. Steckman v. Jackson.

Franklin County, No. 92AP-140. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County.

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, effective October 13, 1993, that oral argument in this case be continued until further order of the court.

93-1994. State v. McCormick.

Lucas County, No. L-92-336. This cause is pending before the court on the filing of a motion for an order directing the Court of Appeals for Lucas County to certify its record and as a claimed appeal as of right from said court. Upon consideration of appellant's motion to stay imposition of sentence,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that said motion be, and the same is hereby, denied, effective October 13, 1993.

93-2001. Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Ohio v. Grigsby.

In Prohibition. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of prohibition. Upon consideration of relator's motion for an alternative writ of prohibition,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion for an alternative writ be, and hereby is, granted, effective October 14, 1993.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that respondent, the Honorable Joseph B. Grigsby, show cause on or before November 3, 1993, why a peremptory writ of prohibition should not be issued.

93-2040. Mayfield Hts. v. Nozik.

Cuyahoga County, No. 64360. This cause is pending before the court on the filing of a motion for an order directing the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County to certify its record and as a claimed appeal as of right from said court. Upon consideration of appellant's motion for stay of execution of sentence,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that said motion be, and the same is hereby, denied.
