MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

94-1739. Ridgeview Ctr., Inc. v. Lorain Cty. Bd. of Revision.
Board of Tax Appeals, No. 92-D-1308. This cause is pending before the
court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. Upon consideration
of appellant's application for dismissal,

IT IS ORDERED by this court that the application be, and the same
is hereby, granted, effective November 21, 1994.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that this cause
be, and hereby is, dismissed.

94-2470. State v. Isham.

Montgomery County, No. 13909. Appellant has filed an untimely notice
of appeal of the court of appeals' decision denying his application
for delayed reconsideration and a motion for delayed appeal. This
appeal involves a civil, post-conviction matter and not an appeal of a
felony case to which the provisions for delayed appeal in S.Ct.Prac.R.
II(2)(A)(4) apply. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that the motion for
delayed appeal be, and hereby is, stricken, effective November 21,
1994.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that, in that
appellant failed to perfect an appeal pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R.
II(2)(A)(1), this case be, and hereby is, dismissed for lack of
jurisdiction.
