This matter originated in this court on the filing of a report by the Commission on Continuing Legal Education (the "commission") pursuant to Gov.Bar R. X(6) (A) (1) (b) and (A) (2) (d). The commission recommended the imposition of sanctions against certain attorneys, including the above-named respondent, for failure to comply with the provisions of Gov.Bar R. X, Attorney Continuing Legal Education, for the 1992-1993 reporting period.

On August 11, 1995, this court adopted the recommendation of the commission, imposed a sanction fee upon the respondent, and suspended the respondent from the practice of law pursuant to Gov.Bar R. X(6) (B) (3), and Gov.Bar R. X(5) (A) (4). The court further ordered that respondent shall not be reinstated to the practice of law in Ohio until respondent complies with the requirements for reinstatement set forth in Gov.Bar R. X(7).

On October 6, 1995, pursuant to Gov.Bar R. X(7) (B) (2), the commission filed respondent's petition for reinstatement and the commission's recommendation finding that the respondent has paid all fees assessed for noncompliance, has made up all deficiencies and is now in full compliance with all requirements of Gov.Bar R. X, and recommending that the respondent be reinstated to the practice of law in Ohio. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that respondent's petition for reinstatement will not be considered until respondent complies with this court's order of August 11, 1995, in particular, the requirements that respondent file an affidavit with the Clerk of this court and the Disciplinary Counsel of the Supreme Court showing compliance with this court's order, and that respondent surrender his certificate of admission to the Clerk of this court.
