96-2220. State ex rel. DPR Properties, Inc. v. Butler Cty. Bd. of Elections. In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus regarding an expedited election matter and was considered in a manner prescribed by law. Upon consideration thereof,
