94-2511. Roberts v. United States Fid. & Guar. Co. Erie County, No. E-93-35. On July 16, 1996, appellant/cross-appellee filed a memorandum in opposition to appellee/cross-appellant's motion for

reconsideration which was due July 15, 1996. Whereas S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV(1)(C) prohibits the filing of a document that is not timely tendered for filing,
