Clermont C.P. No. 96CR005394. On December 15, 1999, this court stayed the execution of sentence in the above-styled cause pending the timely filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari in the Supreme Court of the United States and stayed the execution of sentence in this cause pending exhaustion of state post-conviction remedies in case No. 99-1893. It appearing to the court that this court dismissed the appeal in case No. 99-1893, appellant's post-conviction appeal, on January 19, 2000, and this court received notification from the Supreme Court of the United States that said court on May 1, 2000, entered an order in No. 99-8488, *Jessie James Cowans v. Ohio*, which stated:

"The petition for a writ of certiorari is denied."

IT IS ORDERED by the court, *sua sponte*, that the stays of execution entered in this cause on December 15, 1999, be and are hereby revoked.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by this court that said sentence be carried into execution by the Warden of the Southern Ohio Correctional Facility or, in his absence, by the Deputy Warden on Monday, the 14th day of August, 2000, in accordance with the statutes so provided.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a certified copy of this entry and a warrant under the seal of this court be duly certified to the Warden of the Southern Ohio Correctional Facility and that said Warden shall make due return thereof to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of Clermont County.
