**DISCIPLINARY DOCKET**

**98-401. Toledo Bar Assn. v. Lockhart.**

On November 10, 1998, this court suspended respondent, Carole Ann Lockhart, Attorney Registration No. 0038474, last known address in Toledo, Ohio, from the practice of law for a period of two years, with one year to be stayed and respondent to be placed on probation pursuant to Gov.Bar R. V(6)(B)(3). On June 29, 2000, respondent filed an application for reinstatement; on July 10, 2000, relator, Toledo Bar Association, filed objections to reinstatement or, in the alternative, a motion to stay reinstatement; and on March 8, 2001, relator filed an amended motion to deny or stay reinstatement. On April 25, 2001, the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline filed notice that disciplinary proceedings are currently pending against respondent before the board in board case No. 01-35.

It appearing that disciplinary proceedings are currently pending against respondent before the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline and it further appearing that respondent has not fully complied with this court's order dated November 10, 1998,

IT IS HEREBY ordered by the court that respondent's application for reinstatement be, and hereby is, denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, *sua sponte*, that all documents filed with this court in this case shall meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio, including requirements as to form, number, and timeliness of filings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, *sua sponte*, that service shall be deemed made on respondent by sending this order, and all other orders in this case, by certified mail to the most recent address respondent has given to the Attorney Registration Office.
