01-591. Reedy v. Cincinnati Bengals, Inc.

Hamilton App. Nos. C-000804 and C-000805. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal. Upon consideration of appellants' motion to lift stay and dismiss appeal,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion to lift stay and dismiss appeal be, and hereby is, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed, effective June 29, 2001.

01-761. State ex rel. Smith v. Akron Health Dept.

In Mandamus and Prohibition. On June 27, 2001, relator filed a notice of lack of jurisdiction of entry and demand for a default judgment in Smith's favor. The court finds that the notice is, in substance, a request that the court reconsider its decision entered June 6, 2001. Whereas S.Ct.Prac.R. XI(2)(A), requires that any request for reconsideration in this case be filed no later than June 18, 2001, and whereas S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV(1)(C) prohibits untimely filings,

IT IS ORDERED by the court, *sua sponte*, that the notice of lack of jurisdiction of entry and demand for a default judgment in Smith's favor be, and hereby is, stricken, effective June 29, 2001.
