00-2119. State v. Yarbrough.

Jefferson C.P. No. 99CR116. This cause is pending before the court as a death penalty appeal from the Court of Common Pleas of Jefferson County. Upon consideration of appellant's motion to supplement the record with transcripts of the preliminary hearing held on June 6, 1999 (transcript attached to motion to supplement), and appellant's motion for transcript at state's expense,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motions be, and hereby are, granted.

01-871. State v. Ahmed.

Belmont C.P. No. 99CR192. This cause is pending before the court as a death penalty appeal from the Court of Common Pleas of Belmont County. Upon consideration of appellant's motion for extension of time to transmit the record,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion for extension of time to transmit the record be, and hereby is, granted, and the time for transmitting the record is extended to September 4, 2001.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

01-614. Krihwan Pontiac-GMC Truck, Inc. v. Gen. Motors Corp.

Franklin App. No. 01AP-317. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and a claimed appeal of right. It appears from the records of this court that appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due May 14, 2001, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court and therefore has failed to prosecute this case with the requisite diligence. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that this cause be, and hereby is dismissed, *sua sponte*.

01-956. State ex rel. Klein v. Armstrong.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus. Upon consideration of relators' application for dismissal,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the application for dismissal for, and hereby is, granted.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed.
