**DISCIPLINARY DOCKET**

**99-1163. Cleveland Bar Assn. v. Perry.**

On November 10, 1999, this court suspended respondent, Kirk L. Perry, for a period of eighteen months, with one year of the suspension to be stayed and respondent to be placed on probation for one year on conditions. The court further ordered that the last year of respondent's suspension would not be stayed and respondent would not be placed on probation until, *inter alia*, respondent filed an application requesting that the last year of his suspension be stayed and he be placed on probation and this court stayed the last year of respondent's suspension and placed him on probation. Respondent has not requested a stay of the last year of his suspension and he has not been placed on probation. On June 8, 2001, relator filed a motion to modify order, seeking termination of its responsibility to monitor respondent. Upon consideration thereof,

It appearing to the court that respondent remains under suspension and is not on probation, it is hereby ordered by the court that relator has no monitoring responsibilities until respondent seeks a stay of the final year of his suspension and the court places him on monitored probation.
