MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2002-1017. State ex rel. Tobin v. Hoppel.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus. Upon consideration of relators' request for expedited consideration and request for alternative writ,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the requests for expedited consideration and for alternative writ be, and hereby are, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that the following briefing schedule be set for presentation of evidence and filing of briefs pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. X:

The parties shall file any evidence they intend to present within 20 days of the date of this entry; relators shall file their brief within 10 days after the filing of evidence; respondents shall file their brief within 20 days after the filing of relators' brief; and relators may file a reply brief within 5 days after the filing of respondents' brief.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2002-1031. State ex rel. Laborers' Internatl. Union of N. Am., Local 860 v. Maschari. In Procedendo. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of procedendo. Upon consideration of relator's application for dismissal,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the application for dismissal be, and hereby is, granted.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed.
