MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2002-0810. Moore Personnel Serv. v. Zaino.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 99-R-2098. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. On July 30, 2002, Michael D. Moore, President of Moore Personnel Services, filed a pleading titled "Response to Merit Brief of Appellant" on behalf of Moore Personnel Services. Whereas Michael D. Moore is not an attorney admitted to the practice of law in this state, nor has he sought admission pro hac vice pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. I(2), he is not permitted to file a brief on behalf of a business entity. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that the July 30, 2002 pleading of Moore Personnel Services be, and hereby is, stricken.

2002-1469. State ex rel. Mosley v. Crawford.

In Mandamus and Prohibition.

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for writs of mandamus and prohibition. Upon consideration of relators' motion to expedite proceedings,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion to expedite proceedings be, and hereby is, denied.
