### MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2002-1095. Cleveland Mun. School Dist. Bd. of Edn. v. Cuyahoga Cty. Aud.**

Board of Tax Appeals, Nos. 99-J-1763, 99-J-1764, 99-J-1773 and 99-J-1774. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. Upon consideration of appellant's motion for extension of time to file appellant's merit brief pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV(6)(C),

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion for extension of time be, and hereby is, granted, and appellant's merit brief is due on or before October 21, 2002.

### MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

**2001-1807. Luckenbill v. Hamilton Mut. Ins. Co.**

Darke App. No. 1524, 2001-Ohio-1465. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Darke County. Upon consideration of the parties' joint notice of appellee's payment in settlement of financial obligation and appellee's intent not to file a merit brief or otherwise appear,

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed.

**2002-1437. State v. DeRose.**

Lake App. No. 2000-L-0076, 2002-Ohio-3361 and 2002-Ohio-4357. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and a claimed appeal of right. Upon consideration of appellant's application for dismissal,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the application for dismissal be, and hereby is, granted.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed.
