2002-1580. State ex rel. Daniels v. Indus. Comm.

Franklin App. No. 01AP-1441, 2002-Ohio-3857. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County. Upon consideration of appellant's motion for extension of time to file appellant's merit brief pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV(6)(C),

DISCIPLINARY CASES

1990-2075. Toledo Bar Assn. v. Wingate.

On October 11, 2002, respondent, Ronnie L. Wingate, filed an application for termination of probation. Upon consideration thereof, the court finds that respondent has substantially complied with Gov.Bar R. V(9)(D), and with its order dated February 12, 1992, in which the court reinstated respondent and placed him on monitored probation.
