MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

1985-0007. State v. Williams.

Cuyahoga App. No. 47853. This cause is before the court upon the motion for stay of execution filed by counsel for appellant and the motion for stay of execution filed by appellant pro se. In view of this court's denial of the writ of prohibition in Case No. 2003-1057, *State ex rel. Mason v. Burnside*,

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that the execution of sentence set for June 24, 2003, is stayed pending further order of this court, to allow the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court to proceed in case no. CR-179814.
