MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2002-1956. Tucker v. Wilson.

Clermont App. No. CA2002-01-002, 2002-Ohio-5142. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Clermont County. Upon consideration of appellant's motion to extend time for oral argument scheduled for October 22, 2003,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion to extend time for oral argument be, and hereby is, denied.

2003-1282. Sauvey v. Brondes Ford.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2003-0397. Erie-Huron Counties Grievance Commt. v. Meyerhoefer.

On May 16, 2003, this court indefinitely suspended respondent, Paul F. Meyerhoefer, Attorney Registration No. 0029461, last known business address in Norwalk, Ohio. On August 26, 2003, relator, Erie-Huron Counties Grievance Committee, filed a motion for order to show cause why respondent should not be held in contempt for failing to obey this court's May 16, 2003 order by failing to refund unearned retainers. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by this court that the motion be and is hereby granted to the extent that respondent show cause by filing a written response with the Clerk of this court on or before 20 days from the date of this order why respondent should not be held in contempt.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, sua sponte, that all documents filed with this court in this case shall meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio, including requirements as to form, number, and timeliness of filings.
