MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2003-1653. In re All Kelley & Ferraro Asbestos Cases.

Cuyahoga App. Nos. 78158, 78159, 78299, 78301, 80083, 80332, 80673, and 81576, 153 Ohio App.3d 458, 2003-Ohio-3936. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. On October 17, 2003, a party to this case, C.E. Thurston & Sons, Inc., filed a notice with this court indicating that it was prevented from timely filing a notice of appeal and memorandum in support of jurisdiction in this matter due to its status in federal bankruptcy court. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that the Clerk of this court may accept for filing the notice of appeal and memorandum in support of jurisdiction of C.E. Thurston & Sons, Inc.
