

THE STATE EX REL. HEDDLESON v. BRADSHAW, WARDEN.

Habeas corpus sought to compel relator's immediate release from Mansfield Correctional Institution or an order remanding the cause to common pleas court to allow relator to plead anew to the charges in his indictment — Petition dismissed on authority of Pratts v. Hurley.
