MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2000-0644. State v. Vrabel.

Mahoning App. No. 95CA221, 2000-Ohio-2650. This cause came on for further consideration upon appellee's motion to set execution date and appellant's motion to strike Ohio Public Defender's response to special prosecutor's motion to set an execution date. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion to set execution date be, and hereby is, granted.

Pfeifer, J., dissents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that the motion to strike Ohio Public Defender's response to special prosecutor's motion to set execution date be, and hereby is, denied.

O'Connor, J., dissents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that appellant's sentence be carried into execution by the Warden of the Southern Ohio Correctional Facility or, in his absence, by the Deputy Warden on Wednesday, the 14th day of July, 2004, in accordance with the statutes as provided.
