### **DISCIPLINARY CASES**

## 2001-1882. Stark Cty. Bar Assn. v. Ohlweiler.

On March 27, 2002, this court suspended respondent from the practice of law for two years with the entire two years stayed pending respondent's completion of two years of probation on conditions. On June 7, 2004, relator filed a report regarding respondent's compliance with the court's March 27, 2002 order. Upon consideration thereof,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that respondent show cause on or before 20 days from the date of this order why he should not be found in contempt of this court for failure to fully comply with this court's order of March 27, 2002, to wit, failure to become current with continuing legal education requirements in Ohio and failure to remain in good standing with the Supreme Court of Ohio.
