## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

## 2004-0394. State ex rel. Dispatch Printing Co. v. Johnson.

In Mandamus. On S.Ct.Prac.R. X(5) determination, relators' amended complaint, relators' motion to file instanter verification, respondents' motions to dismiss, respondents' motion for protective order, and motions to intervene of Ohio Civil Service Employees Association, AFSME, Local 11, AFL-CIO and Ohio Education Association.

Upon consideration, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that relators' motion to file instanter verification is GRANTED and that respondents' motions to dismiss are DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondents' motion for protective order is GRANTED insofar as relators' discovery seeks state employee home addresses. Respondents' motion for a protective order is DENIED in all other respects.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motions of Ohio Civil Service Employees Association, AFSCME, Local 11, AFL-CIO and Ohio Education Association are granted, and they are permitted to intervene as respondents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an alternative writ is GRANTED. The parties' evidence will be due 45 days from the date of this entry, relators' brief is due 20 days after the parties' evidence is filed, respondents' briefs are due 30 days from the date relators' brief is filed, and relators' reply brief is due 10 days thereafter.
