MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2004-0144. State v. Willis.

Cuyahoga App. No. 82313, 2003-Ohio-6329. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that the stay of briefing is dissolved, and this cause is no longer held for the decision in Supreme Court case No. 02-1888, *State v. Jordan*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that the Clerk shall issue an order for the transmittal of the record from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County and that briefing shall proceed in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. VI.
