MERIT DECISIONS WITHOUT OPINIONS

2005-2185. State ex rel. McCourt v. Spurgeon.

In Prohibition. On relator's motion for issuance of an immediate alternative writ. Motion denied. On S.Ct.Prac.R. X(5) determination, cause dismissed.

Pfeifer, Lundberg Stratton, O'Connor and O'Donnell, JJ., concur.

Moyer, C.J., and Resnick, J., dissent and would not expedite the S.Ct.Prac.R. X(5) determination.

Lanzinger, J., not participating.
