RECONSIDERATION OF PRIOR DECISIONS

2006-1798. Kirchner v. Shooters on the Water, Inc.

Cuyahoga App. No. 86919, 2006-Ohio-3583. Reported at ___ Ohio St.3d ___, 2006-Ohio-5474, ___ N.E.2d ___. On motion for reconsideration. This cause was dismissed because the check counsel for appellant tendered for the filing fee in this case was returned due to a stop payment order. Counsel has filed a motion for reconsideration and tendered a second check for the filing fee. Upon consideration thereof,

It is ordered by the court that the motion for reconsideration is denied.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of this court return the check tendered with the motion for reconsideration to counsel for appellant.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

1996-2495. In re Judicial Campaign Complaint Against Hildebrandt.

On October 13, 2006, respondent, Lee Hildebrandt Jr., Attorney Registration No. 0020976, last known business address in Cincinnati, Ohio, submitted a letter to the chair of the commission of five judges appointed by the Supreme Court of Ohio that will be considered an application for termination of probation. Upon consideration thereof, the commission finds that respondent has substantially complied with its order dated June 3, 1997, in which the commission suspended respondent for a period of six months, stayed the suspension, and placed respondent on probation for six months, effective June 17, 1997, subject to the respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the order.

Therefore, it is ordered by the commission that the probation of respondent is terminated.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(1), that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(2), and that respondent bear the costs of publication.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2006-1620. Watson v. Thompson.
