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## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2006-0456. Charter Steel-Cleveland, Inc. v. Cuyahoga Cty. Bd. of Revision.**

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2004-V-538. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. Upon consideration of the parties' joint motion to vacate the decision and order of the Board of Tax Appeals and to remand this cause to the Board of Tax Appeals,

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals with instructions to remand to the Cuyahoga County Board of Revision to implement the settlement agreement of the parties.

### **2006-1942. In re K.M..**

Cuyahoga App. Nos. 87882 and 87883, 2006-Ohio-4878. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal involving termination of parental rights/adoption. Upon consideration of appellant's motion for stay of the court of appeals' judgment,
