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## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2007-0178. Wilson v. AC&S, Inc.**

Butler App. No. CA2006-03-056, 2006-Ohio-6704. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. On March 9, 2007, appellees filed a motion to strike the appellant's notice of appeal, memorandum in support of jurisdiction, and case information statement filed with this court on January 31, 2007. Whereas appellees assert in their motion to strike that they have not been served with these documents as required by S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV(2)(A),

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that appellant show cause within fourteen days of the date of this entry why this court should not strike appellant's notice of appeal, memorandum in support of jurisdiction, and case information statement and dismiss this case.

## MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

### **2007-0367. Garmon v. Mills.**

Lucas App. No. L-06-1173. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. On February 26, 2007, when this appeal was filed, a check in the amount of \$40.00 was submitted by counsel for appellant to satisfy the requirement of the docket fee imposed by R.C. 2503.17 and S.Ct.Prac.R. XV(1). This court has been informed by the Office of the Treasurer of the State of Ohio that the check was returned because of insufficient funds. Whereas R.C. 2503.17 and S.Ct.Prac.R. XV(1) require that the docket fee shall be paid before a notice of appeal is filed or a case is docketed,

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is dismissed.
