## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2006-1207. Pack v. Osborn.**

Licking App. No. 05 CA 83, 2006-Ohio-2253. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Licking County. Upon consideration of the joint motion to allow amicus curiae, Ohio Attorney General Marc Dann, to participate in oral argument scheduled for April 18, 2007, in support of the appellant,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted and amicus curiae shall share the time allotted to appellant.

### **2006-1212. Arbino v. Johnson & Johnson.**

Certified Question of State Law, United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio, Western Division, No. 3:06 CV 40010. This cause is pending before the court on the certification of a state law question from the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio, Western Division. Upon consideration of petitioner's motion to extend time for oral argument scheduled for May 1, 2007,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

### **2006-1343. Pack v. Osborn.**

Licking App. No. 05 CA 83, 2006-Ohio-2253. This cause is pending before the court on the certification of a conflict by the Court of Appeals for Licking County. Upon consideration of the joint motion to allow amicus curiae, Ohio Attorney General Marc Dann, to participate in oral argument scheduled for April 18, 2007, in support of the appellant,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted and amicus curiae shall share the time allotted to appellant.

**2007-0072. State ex rel. Douglas v. Greenfield City Council.**

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus involving an expedited election matter. Upon consideration of the joint motion to continue stay of briefing schedule pending execution of settlement,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. No further motions for stay of briefing shall be filed.

**2007-0085. In re Estate of Nipper.**

Summit App. No. 23125, 2006-Ohio-6753. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal. On February 28, 2007, appellant filed a notice of pending settlement. Whereas appellant has neither notified this court of the status of settlement nor filed an application for dismissal,

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that appellant show cause within fourteen days of the date of this entry why this court should not proceed to consider the jurisdictional memoranda in this appeal pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. III(6).

**2007-0313. State v. Gillingham.**

Montgomery App. No. 20671, 2006-Ohio-5758. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. Upon consideration of the motion of Dean Boland to withdraw as counsel for appellant,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted.
