## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

#### 2007-1576. State ex rel. Collins v. Burge.

In Prohibition. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of prohibition. Upon consideration of relators' motion for emergency issuance of an alternative writ of prohibition,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

#### 2007-1608. Sull v. Kaim.

Cuyahoga App. No. 88541, 2007-Ohio-3269. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. Upon consideration of appellees' motion to strike notice of appeal and memorandum in support of jurisdiction,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied. Appellees' memorandum in response is due 30 days from the date of this entry.

## MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

#### 2007-1681. Porter v. Lamb.

Summit App. No. 23819. This cause was filed as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. Upon consideration of appellant's jurisdictional memorandum, it is determined by the court that this cause originated in the court of appeals and, therefore, should proceed as an appeal of right pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. II(1)(A)(1).
