MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2007-1753. State ex rel. Fishman v. Lucas Cty. Bd. of Elections, Slip Opinion No. 2007-Ohio-5583.

In Prohibition. Writ denied.

Moyer, C.J., and Lundberg Stratton, O'Connor, O'Donnell, Lanzinger, and Cupp, JJ., concur.

Pfeifer, J., dissents and would grant an alternative writ.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2006-1126. State v. Dean.

Clark C.P. No. 05CR0348. This cause is pending before the court as a death penalty appeal from the Court of Common Pleas of Clark County. Upon consideration of appellant's motion to supplement the record,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

2007-0328. Marc Glassman, Inc. v. Levin.

Cuyahoga App. No. 87766. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County. Upon consideration of the joint motion of appellee, Marc Glassman, Inc., and amicus curiae, Ohio Pharmacists Association et al., for divided oral argument time for the oral argument scheduled for February 5, 2008,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted, and amicus curiae shall share the time allotted to appellee.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2007-1581. Cleveland Bar Assn. v. Mitchell.

This cause is pending before the court upon the filing of a report by the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline. Upon consideration of respondent's motion to waive the copying requirement,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.
