MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2006-1971. State ex rel. Griffin v. State.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus. Upon consideration of relator's motion for reparations,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2007-0343. Disciplinary Counsel v. Morgan.

This cause is before the court upon respondent's filing of an affidavit of compliance on October 30, 2007. Upon consideration thereof,

It is ordered that respondent file, within 20 days of the date of this order, an affidavit that meets the requirements of the court's suspension order of July 18, 2007. The affidavit shall include, inter alia, details of how respondent has complied with the notification requirements of the order and proof that such notices have been sent by certified mail. If the requirements set forth in the order are inapplicable to respondent, his affidavit shall include a statement explaining why they are inapplicable.

It is further ordered that if respondent fails to comply with this order within 20 days of the date of this order, he shall be held in contempt and will not be reinstated until he fully complies.

2007-1329. In re Schram.

This cause is before the court upon respondent's response to the show cause order issued by this court on October 16, 2007. Upon consideration thereof,

It is ordered that no action shall be taken at this time, provided respondent files her affidavit within ten days of the date of this order.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2007-1826. Lynch v. Studebaker.

Cuyahoga App. No. 88117, 2007-Ohio-4014. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. Upon consideration of the joint application for dismissal of appeal and cross-appeal,

It is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal of appeal and cross-appeal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.

2007-1847. Poland v. Beatty.

Erie App. No. E-07-041. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal. Upon consideration of appellants' application for dismissal,

It is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
