## DISCIPLINARY CASES

**2007-0734. Medina County Bar Assn. v. Butts.**

On March 18, 2008, respondent, Michael Thomas Butts, Attorney Registration No. 0046616, last known business address in Medina, Ohio, filed an application for termination of probation. Upon consideration thereof, the court finds that respondent has substantially complied with Gov.Bar R. V(9)(D) and with its order dated August 29, 2007, in which the court suspended respondent for a period of six months, stayed the entire suspension, and placed respondent on monitored probation for six months on conditions.

Therefore, it is ordered by this court that the probation of respondent is terminated.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(1), that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(2), and that respondent bear the costs of publication.
