## MERIT DECISIONS WITHOUT OPINIONS

### **2009-0414. State ex rel. Stoll v. State Teachers Retirement Bd.**

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus involving an expedited election matter. Upon consideration of relator's complaint and respondent's answer,

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this case is removed from the expedited-election docket. Further, upon consideration pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. X(5), this cause is dismissed.

Pfeifer, Lundberg Stratton, O'Donnell, Lanzinger, and Cupp, JJ., concur.

Moyer, C.J., and O'Connor, J., concur in removing the case from the expedited-election docket but would grant the writ to compel production of the records.

## DISCIPLINARY CASES

### **2008-2381. Cleveland Metro. Bar Assn. v. Sayler.**

This cause is pending before the court upon the filing of a report by the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline. Upon consideration of relator's motion to remand, or in the alternative to participate in oral argument,

It is ordered by the court that the motion to remand is granted. This matter is hereby remanded to the board for further proceedings. Proceedings before this court in this case are stayed until further order of the court. Costs to abide final determination of the case.

It is further ordered that oral argument scheduled for March 24, 2009, is cancelled until further order of the court.
