MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2008-2465. Hird Ave. Properties, L.L.C. v. Cuyahoga Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, Nos. 2007-M-163 and 2007-M-164. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals. Upon consideration of the parties' joint motion to remand,

It is ordered by the court that the motion is granted, and this cause is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals to implement the settlement agreement of the parties.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to the Board of Tax Appeals by certifying a copy of this judgment entry and filing it with the Board of Tax Appeals.

2009-0267. State ex rel. Ohio Concrete Constr. Assn. v. Ohio Dept. of Transp.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus. Upon consideration of the relator's notice of correction filed on March 24, 2009,

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that the notice of correction is stricken because it is prohibited by S.Ct.Prac.R. VIII(7).

2009-0530. Hughley v. Saunders.

Fairfield App. No. 09 CA 6, 2009-Ohio-1294. This cause was filed as a discretionary appeal and a claimed appeal of right. Upon consideration of appellant's jurisdictional memorandum, it is determined by the court that this cause originated in the court of appeals and, therefore, should proceed as an appeal of right pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. II(1)(A)(1).

It is ordered by the court that the Clerk shall issue an order for the transmission of the record from the Court of Appeals for Fairfield County, and the parties shall brief this case in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. VI.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2007-0333. Disciplinary Counsel v. Broeren.

It is ordered by this court, sua sponte, that P. Robert Broeren, Attorney Registration No. 0069166, last known business address in Gambier, Ohio, is found in contempt for failure to comply with this court's order of October 10, 2007, to wit: failure to file an affidavit of compliance on or before November 9, 2007.

2009-0171. State v. Terry.

Darke App. No. 1730, 2008-Ohio-6738. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right. Upon consideration of appellant's application for dismissal,
