1. An amendment to Rule 4.2 of the amended Code of Judicial Conduct has been adopted. The amendment will become effective with the amended Code of Judicial Conduct on March 1, 2009. The amendment to Rule 4.2 modifies division (C)(6) and Comment [2] and adds new divisions (B)(4) and (C)(7), allowing party affiliation or membership to be communicated in person or in advertising through the date of the primary election.

Moyer, C.J., and Lundberg Stratton, O'Connor, O'Donnell, and Cupp, JJ., concurred in adopting the amendment.

Pfeifer and Lanzinger, JJ., dissented, citing the First Amendment principles expressed in *Republican Party of Minnesota v. White* (2002), 536 U.S. 765, 122 S.Ct. 2528, 153 L.Ed.2d 694.
