On December 5, 2008, the Commission on Continuing Legal Education (“commission”) imposed sanctions against certain attorneys, including the above-

named respondent, for failure to comply with the applicable continuing legal education provisions of Gov.Bar R. X for the 2006/2007 reporting period. Specifically, respondent failed to comply with the hour requirement of Gov.Bar R. X(3)(A) and with the filing requirement of Gov.Bar R. X(3)(B)(1).

It has now come to the commission's attention that the respondent was eligible for an exemption from the hour requirement pursuant to Gov.Bar R. X(3)(F)(1) during the 2006/2007 reporting period.

Respondent has submitted the appropriate paperwork to request and be granted an exemption for the time period of January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2007. The commission has granted respondent's exemption for this time period and, accordingly, he is exempted from the continuing legal education hour requirement for the 2006/2007 reporting period. Upon consideration thereof,

It is ordered by the commission that the sanction issued against the above-named respondent is hereby modified to a sanction for failure to comply with Gov.Bar R. X(3)(B)(1), and respondent is hereby ordered to pay to the commission, within 30 days of the date of this order, a sanction fee in the amount of \$150.
